As parents know, all of our classes are mixed year group as we only have 3 classes, not the 7 which a single form entry school would have. In our current class structure, your child will be in the same class as the rest of their year group in YR, Y1, Y3, Y5 and Y6 but could be split in Y2 and/or Y4.

It is not the case that a child has been 'moved up' or 'kept down' at Green Haworth. In some schools, the decision is made purely on age or on academic attainment. However, this is not the case here; we take the view of the 'whole child' and consider various factors (including but not limited to):

- age
- balance of SEND within the classes
- separating siblings and twins where possible
- gender split within the class; balance of SEND across classes
- readiness to learn / independent skills / academic attainment
- social, emotional and behavioural needs
- peer / friendship group

Please note that, on Thursday 2 July, current **Year 6 children should attend their new High School rather than Green Haworth.**
